## Board of Trustees Approve Changes in Admission Policy

The Texas College Board of Trustees met on campus on October 17, 2008 and approved an important change in the Admissions Policy that will have positive implications regarding the open enrollment status.

Effective January 1, 2009, the change will require the following for students seeking admission to the four-year baccalaureate degree granting institution:

- All students must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 on a 4.00 scale.
- Students must have successfully completed either the ACT or SAT national standardized examinations prior to admission.

While the College continues to retain its commitment to those students who need additional preparation, students who do not meet these criteria may enroll in the two-year Associate of Arts (AA) degree program in general studies. After completion of the AA degree program, a student may petition to enroll for the baccalaureate degree program.
