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ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES

A freshman applicant for admission to Texas College must have graduated from an accredited high school with a minimum of sixteen Carnegie units or have successfully completed the General Education Development (GED) Testing Program. The distribution of units should be as follows:

Applicants seeking admittance into Texas College must submit the following:

- * An Application for Admission
- * \$20.00 Application processing fee. This fee is non-refundable and must be in the form of cash or a money order. Personal checks are not accepted.
- * An official high school transcript with signature and seal (if applicable) mailed directly from the high school to the College or where applicable, the GENERAL EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT (GED) Testing Program score report.

For Transfer Students – include the following items in addition to items stated above:

- * Official academic transcript (s) from all colleges/universities attended mailed directly from the college/university to the Texas College Office of Admission. (High School transcript if entering with less than 12 college hours)
- * A Texas College Transfer Student Reference Sheet. (To be completed by the Student Affairs Officer at previous school)

The following items are necessary to complete the admissions files:

- * A medical examination report and proof of insurance coverage for all applicants;
- * Copy of the social security card;
- * Copy ACT, SAT, or THEA (used for diagnostic purpose and placement test)
